Welcome to Year 6 Evening

Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that this letter finds you and your families well at this time. We would like to inform parents of our Year 6 children about a Welcome to Year 6 Information Evening on **Thursday 17th October** at **4.30pm** in the **Main Hall**. All adults can enter through the community entrance where you will be greeted by a Year 6 member of staff. The aim of this evening is to support you in understanding the structure of Year 6, to discuss the routines and expectations of the year, to explain how we will be supporting your child's transition to high school and to explain how we will be supporting pupils to maximise their progress this year. During this evening, we will be sharing Statutory Assessment information and key dates with you for our year group. All of the information from this evening will remain available after this time on our school website for you to view at your own convenience.

We will also share information about the residential and upcoming trips. This will give you an opportunity to ask any questions that you might have. If your child has a medical need, including allergies or you feel they may need additional support, we urge you to attend the meeting so that details can be shared with staff members afterwards. Please note that all medicines, along with an administering medicine permission form, should be handed to teachers by **Monday 28th October 2024** in order to allow this to be cross referenced against medical forms and the appropriate risk assessment and paperwork to be completed. The only exception to this, would be when medicine has been prescribed by a doctor after this date; in this instance, we ask that you share details as soon as possible.

During the evening, we will be discussing the success of CGP books in supporting children with their learning, including the SATs revision guides to support their knowledge and understanding and the SATs 10-minute test books, to support their application of skills and experience of different question styles. As a school, we are able to purchase these books at a significantly discounted rate, therefore if you wish to purchase any of these books from the list below to support your child with their learning at home, please order online via Parentmail by **Friday 1st November**, we will inform parents once the books have been delivered and are available to be sent home via bookbags.
