<u>English</u>

Within English this half term our learning will be based around stories from around the world



including 'The King who was eaten for breakfast' and 'Rama and Sita'.

We will also be looking at non-chronological reports linking with our theme 'Spice World'.

Within these genres we will be looking at description, sentence openers, adverbs, conjunctions, writing structure, sentence types and writing at length.

We will be focusing on comprehension and inference skills during Guided Reading and encouraging pupils to discuss what they have read.

We will be practicing spelling rules within spelling including common exception words, contractions, suffixes and prefixes.

<u>PE</u>

This term in P.E we will be ball skills and Active Play. Please ensure children have full kit (white t-shirt, black shorts or trousers and trainers), hair tied back and no jewellery.

Computing

<u>Theme</u>

Capacity, Mass and Temperature
