#### English

Our English learning will be made up of a combination of grammar, spelling, reading, handwriting and composition work.

Whole class guided reading will take place every day, whilst daily grammar will be taught as part of the main English lesson.

We start the term by looking at different forms of poetry and we will have the chance to produce some of our own Roman themed poems.

We will be learning about instruction texts. We will be looking at the features of an instruction text, focussing on imperative verbs and adverbs and we will be analysing good and bad texts.

Towards the end of the topic, we will be baking our own Roman bread and the children will then write their own instructions on how to make it!

To support your child at home, please encourage them to talk with you about our English topics. Ask your child if they can give you really specific instructions for you to complete! Can you do it exactly as they say?

#### Theme


DT - Catapults. How far can you catapult the sweet? We will be researching, designing and making our own Roman catapults.

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
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
