

English

Within English this term our Talk4Writing story is: The Smartest Giant in Town.

The curriculum areas we will be covering are:

- Wishing tales
- Recount

Within these genres we will be looking at handwriting, spelling patterns, expanded noun phrases (using adjective to describe a noun), conjunctions and a words that contain suffixes (words that end in -ed -ing etc).

We are continuing with stage 5 phonics this half term and are looking into split diagraphs. We will be having a focus on pupils recognising diagraphs and split diagraphs in words.

PE

Maths

Within maths this term we will be learning about:

Multiplication and Division

This term we will be focusing on a range of methods to solve multiplication and division sums.

Weight

We are looking at measuring and recording mass/weight. We will also be solving practical problems involving mass/weight.

Money

We will be recognising the value of different coins and notes and become familiar with handling coins up to 20p.

Position and direction

We will be exploring positional language and using everyday words such as: top, middle, bottom, near etc to describe position and movement. We will also be using the language: quarter, half and three-quarter turns to describe movement.

Theme

This year our theme our focus is 'Down Under!'. Within this theme we will cover 3 questions:

Art - Is dot painting the best way to decorate a boomerang?

Geography - What would a kookaburra see flying through Australia?

Science - Where do the Australian animals live?

In R.E Elm class will be learning about the religion Christianity through the Big Question - 'Why was Jesus welcomed like a king or celebrity by the crowds on Palm Sunday?'
