We are focusing on respecting others.

Dear parents, carers and families,

This week is a busy one, it is anti-bullying week so all the children will be having lessons that are focused on understanding what is bullying and how they can be supported if it happens to them. The theme for this year is Reach Out so we will be focusing on ensuring they are clear on what to do if they every experience bulling and who is a safe adult to reach out to.

To support children with developing fluency in times tables, we have introduced Times Table Rock Stars for children in Y2 to Y6. The website can be accessed at: <u>https://ttrockstars.com/</u> and the children have been provided with their log in details. We have received very positive feedback about this on-line learning website from other schools. There are different games on the website that children can play to practise their recall of the times tables and the related division facts. The system has a clever algorithm that provides children with targeted questions on their individual multiplication and division knowledge and advances as they play. The website has a 'rock star' theme and children create their own avatar, which ensures their identity is kept anonymous. Children can earn imaginary coins as they become more successful in answering the questions and competing in the games.
