English

This book we are focusing on this term is 'Owl Babies' by Martin Waddell. We will use this to support children's personal social and emotion feelings, as well as their literacy skills. We will be focusing on sentence writing his term.

We will also look at non-fiction books in order to promote children learning about animals by reading.

Maths

This term we will be recapping:

- Combing 2 groups to find a total
- Number formation

Theme

Within theme, we will be looking at different animals. We will be having a science focus where we learning about habitats and what animals need to survive.

PE

Children will do forest school on a Tuesday afternoon. They will need a warm coat, wellies and any waterproof clothing (if they have it). They will go out in all weathers. We will also be doing P.E on a Monday afternoon, children will need indoor kit each week.

Communication and Language (CI)

Physical Development (PD)

Reading books

Reading books will be changed daily. Please ensure children are reading regularly at home and that you leave a note in their records.

Personal, Social, Emotion Development (PSED)

This term we will be focusing on transitioning children back into school. As children have had so much time at the home, the focus will be friendships. We will spend lots of time playing games and allowing children time to talk.
