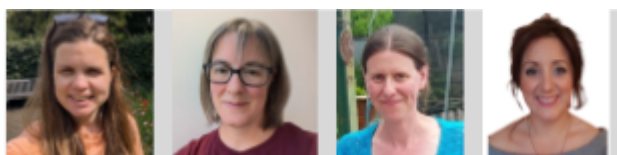
Supporters Of Chesterton School - Your Parent Teacher Association
