

Phonics

By the end of this term, children have learnt all of phase 2 and phase 3 sounds. These are all the sounds they will be taught in Reception. The focus this term is to ensure they are secure with the sounds, and are able to apply them independently to reading and writing. We will also focus on ensuring children recognise tricky words and are able to apply them.

Phase 2 tricky words: I, no, the, to, go, into

Phase 3 tricky words: he, she, we, me, be, you, are, her, was, all, they, my

English

The book we are focusing on this term is 'The Night Pirates'. Through this Talk4Writing unit, we will be using adjectives to describe the setting and characters. We will be writing sentences to show description and to begin to write short stories.

We will also look at non-fiction books in order to promote children learning about different sea animals.


Maths

This term we will be focusing on:

- Doubling

Theme

PE

Communication and Language (Cl)

Personal, Social, Emotion Development (PSED)

This term we will be primarily focusing on children's emotions, especially focusing on their transition into year 1. We will allow time to discuss their move up and talk about any worries they may have. Children will have an opportunity to get to know their new teacher this term.

Reading

Reading books are changed daily. It is vital children are reading regularly at home and that you leave a note in their records.
