Hawthorn Class - Curriculum Overview

Autumn I - 2022

English

- Our English learning will be made up of a combination of grammar, spelling, reading, handwriting and composition work.
- Our Talk4Writing focus is creating narratives. The children will be using their creative skills to build interesting and creative narratives whilst storytelling.
- Our focus book for this term is "Georges's Secret Key to the Universe" written by Lucy and Stephen Hawking
- Guided reading focuses this half-term on core and intent across a range of texts.

Physical Education

Hawthorn will be **swimming** half-term, building confidence in the water and developing core swimming techniques. We will also take part in a weekly lesson building passing, catching, moving, defending, positioning and shooting skills.

Science, Geography, Design Tech, and Computing

- Science Would a day be longer on the moon? Children will learn to identify, classify and recognise objects in the solar system and the vocabulary required to talk about celestial events and the nighttime sky.
- Geography Is there anybody out there? In Geography, we'll learn how continents, countries, biomes and other geographic features are identified, classified and mapped.
- Design & Technology The Best Way to Travel! Using space travel as a vehicle, we will think about the essential needs, wants and desires that human beings require to survive.
- Computing Systems

What makes a system a system? We will look at a range of analogue and digital systems and discover how the computing revolution has improved products and our lives through automation. We will be **using physical computing resources to build our own digital systems**.

Mathematics

- Our mornings in Hawthorn will begin with an LBQ (Learning By Questions) revision task on iPads.
- We will begin the term revising and consolidating place value before moving on to developing confidence, accuracy and efficiency in arithmetic.
- Every Thursday afternoon, the students will work on core arithmetic assessments as part of the PiXL program which culminates with all Year-5 students undertaking a range of PiXL assessments on the week beginning 10th October 2022.
- We'll finish up the lead up to half-term working on developing fluency and applying mathematical skills though a range of **problem solving** and **reasoning tasks**.

Music

During our music lessons this half-term we will be focusing on **producing** and **evaluating** a range of musical genres and developing the understanding and vocabulary to **critically discuss their compositions**.

MFL (Spanish)

This half-term the children will learn how to name a range of animals. They will continue to use the Language Angels curriculum to develop a range of core Spanish speaking, listening and writing skills with a particular focus on Spanish grammar.

PSHE and RE

How do Hindu's demonstrate commitment? - Focusing on behaviour and belonging, the children will learn **how Hindu's show commitment to God** and discuss critically what 'the best way' means to individuals. PSHE this half-term will allow the children to consider their sense of 'self.' They will explore their own sense of responsibility, morilty and ethics and how they affect others.
