Parents will have an opportunity to meet with class teachers after half term, when we hold our first Parent Conferencing sessions



MEDICINES AND INHALERS IN SCHOOL

We have recently noted some children bringing medication into school in their bags to selfadminister during the day. This is NOT allowed under any circumstances and <u>all</u> medicines, including inhalers, should be delivered to the School Office for safe-keeping and supervised administration by a member of staff. Please note that we require written instructions/consent from parents before we are able to administer any medication - a form for this purpose is available on the school website <u>https://www.chewstokeacademy.org/parentinformation/forms-and-information-for-parents</u> These rules include medication purchased 'over the counter' as well as that provided on prescription.

<u>Inhalers</u> As stated above, these should be delivered to the School Office in the first instance for safe-keeping. However, if your child is likely to require frequent access to their inhaler, we are happy for an inhaler to be kept in the classroom for your child to request from the teacher when required.
