This week many of our children took part in our Christmas plays or concerts; all of the productions were fantastic and we are extremely proud of all of the children who took part - well done.



It is always such a beautiful sight to see all the Christingles lit and to hear the first Christmas carols of the festive season. We hope our families enjoyed it as much as we did! The donations taken at the service will be split between The Children's Society and our partner school in Uganda. Our partner school, Christian Life School, is

raising money to buy bricks to build much-needed new classrooms. The cost of each brick is just 4p, so we hope our donation will help buy several thousand bricks for the project. We had a number of parents ask if they could donate online to the project, we now have a link on ParentPay if you would like to do this.

We now have a total for the amount raised at the Christmas Fayre, which was approximately £1000, an amazing amount of money. This doesn't yet include the raffle which will be drawn later in the week. I would like to thank our Chairs of the PTA, Hayley and Lucy, Claire as Treasurer and the rest of the PTA for their efforts. The money raised by the PTA makes a huge difference in school; the PTA has subsidised the theatre trips for us this month and made a large donation to the improvements to the large playground.
