We can proudly announce that, for the fourth year running, Chew Stoke Church School has won both the Local Authority and the South West Region School of the Year Awards for our



commitment to promoting sustainable and active travel, especially for journeys to and from school. There are thousands of schools nationally who hold accreditations with Modeshift Stars and only a handful are put forward for these awards. It is an amazing achievement! We will now progress to the National Awards which will take place in London in March.

We're delighted to share that our pupils have once again achieved exceptional results at the end of the last academic year. These outstanding outcomes firmly establish us as one of the highest-performing schools in the Bath and North East Somerset area.

Our Key Stage 2 pupils excelled in the 2024 SATs, demonstrating strong attainment across all subjects. Notably, they outperformed the national average in reading, writing, maths, and science.
