# Lots of reminders this week as we start a new academic year:

- Your child should bring a water bottle and a waterproof jacket to school every day. They should be in school uniform from Monday-Thursday and can wear their 'home' clothes on Fridays.
- Please label your children's clothes with their name so we can return lost property to them. If you need more school uniform please come to our 'pre-loved' uniform store in the school office. All items are free to those who need them or can be paid for in cash at the office.
- We are a nut-free school because we have children with serious allergies. Children must not bring anything into school that contains nuts and if they bring in a packed lunch containing nuts (including Nutella spread), they won't be allowed to eat it. Parents will be called to bring in an alternative lunch or a school lunch will be provided.
- Our free English language class for parents will be in the schoolhouse every Monday from 9-11am. Please come along to register on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> if you would like to attend the class for the first time or have already been attending.
- We have a para-legal specialising in cost-ofliving matters, debt and benefits in school every Tuesday morning. Ask Ruth at the gate in the morning or email <u>rcrossan.211@lgflmail.org</u> to make an appointment for this free service.
- Children attending Nursery full-time need to pay for lunches at £11.75 a week unless they are entitled to free school meals. Please pay in advance by card at the office or by parentpay.
- There will be a meeting for Year 6 parents on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> at 9am in the library. We will talk about school journey and secondary school applications.
