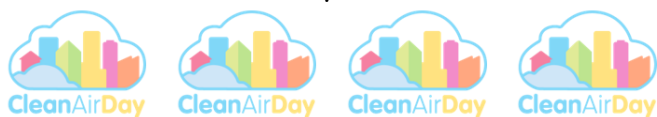
Hello!
