### Hello

The Year 1 children have settled in well to their bubbles and are working hard to practise their social distancing. There are a few places left in these bubbles, so if you have a Year 1 child and would like to send them to school please give us a call. After next week we won't accept any more children into the bubble as it will prove too disruptive.

Reception children start on Monday in one bubble, and although we are apprehensive about how they may find it, we are looking forward to seeing them.

With these bubbles in place, and the key worker bubbles now at capacity, we find ourselves stretched in terms of teachers. The bubbles cannot have more than 15 children in them, and in most classrooms no more than 11 to be safe. Obviously each one needs a teacher and we are not prepared to have supply teachers who do not know the children at this time. The remaining teachers are planning the home-learning, making the telephone calls to check on our families and children as well as carrying out other essential tasks. We will not be able to open more widely, as we do not have the capacity within the guidelines.

I am so grateful to have such dedicated staff, some of whom are catching trains at 5am, others running miles to avoid public transport, or distancing themselves from their families because of their vulnerabilities in order to come into work. I want to say thank you to them.
