We have had a very studious week in school. All classes have been working very hard when I have been around and about, and it was great to welcome Year 2 and the EYFS back. And they were very reflective about kindness, although many gave examples about children not always being kind, others talked of the kindness they are shown daily. One Year 5 child talked of friendship, 'Friends build up with friendship and love and kindness.'
