Maths

We will become confident with place value to 10, by singing number rhymes, counting forwards and backwards, and reading and writing numerals. We will be practising counting objects using one to one correspondence. We will learn how to order numbers along a number line. We will be adding and subtracting numbers within 10 using manipulatives and visual models to support.

Art and Design Technology

We will be exploring the art work of the **Fauvism** movement, talking about different pieces and **expressing our views**. We will create our own pictures using the **pointillism** technique. We will try out **colour mixing**.

Enalish

We will be completing our **Phase 4 Phonics** unit. Our core texts will explore the theme of bravery and include the traditional tale **Little Red Riding Hood** and the alternative version **Little Red and the Very Hungry Lion** by Alex T. Smith. We will also be reading **A Brave Bear** by Sean Taylor. We will be using the texts as prompts to **read and write sentences**. The children will be encouraged throughout to use their phonics knowledge to read and write words and sentences.

Science

Our unit is called **Ourselves**. We will be learning about the **different parts of the body** and labelling the body parts. We will be discussing the **five senses** of sight, hearing, taste, touch, and smell. We will be carrying out **investigations** which encourage us to think carefully about each of the senses.

History

We will be exploring the question "How am I making history?" The children will be creating a timeline and mapping out key events in their lives so far, including birthdays and special memories. Children will be exploring photos and artefacts. We will also be talking about the toys they have liked to play with during their lives. We will finish our unit by learning about toys in the past and visiting the Young V&A in Bethnal Green.

Jigsaw (PSHE)

Our unit is called **Being Me**. We will be learning about the **Zones of Regulation** and how to use the charts in our classrooms to show how we are feeling. We will continue to learn about the **UN Rights of the Child**. The children will be introduced to our mascot **Jigsaw Jack** and they will take part in fun games and activities that develop their understanding of their rights.

Physical Education (PE)

In PE, our units will be Team
Building and Fundamentals.
Children will be learning how to work with a partner and as part of a team. The children will develop their listening, talking and sharing skills. They will also explore balance, stability and landing safely and the different ways their bodies can move. Additionally, they will look at how to change direction and speed. They will explore jumping, hopping and skipping actions.

Music

Our key song is called **Hey You!** and has an 'old school hip hop' style. We will use the song to explore how pulse, rhythm and pitch work together. We will also be singing songs about ourselves and Autumn.
