This Week in the EYFS.

We have continued our Christmas preparations, and our classrooms are beginning to look very festive with Christmas trees and decorations appearing all over the setting. We have also begun practising the Christmas songs and rhymes which we hope you will enjoy hearing during the festive season, and which we will be recording for you to share with family and friends.









Nursery have a weekly focus letter/sound in phonics and this week it has been **Nn** for net, narwhal and number nine. We are thinking about things that begin with that letter/sound and are clapping the syllables in each word to develop our phonological awareness. We have now completed the THEP Phonics Programme Set 1 letters and sounds. We have been reading many different versions of the story of Jack and the Beanstalk ahead of our pantomime.

Reception have completed Phase 2 of the THEP Phonics programme and have been using their developing phonic knowledge to read and write sentences including writing letters to Father Christmas! They have been learning about the different ways that Christmas is celebrated.

On Thursday we all enjoyed a visit from the **Hobgoblin Theatre Company** for a performance and drama workshop of 'Jack & The **Beanstalk'**. Thank you to all those who contributed £2 towards the cost of this event





Clothing, Water Bottles & Lost Property

As it is now officially Winter, please ensure that your child wears appropriate clothes to school including a **weatherproof coat** and **footwear**.
