The half-term holiday will be from **Monday 24th-Friday 28th October**.







Learning Together for a Better Future

During this term our topic in Reception will be '**Me, Myself & I'** whilst in Nursery it's '**All About Me!'**. Nursery staff have enjoyed reading the 'All About Me' booklets whilst Reception children have been sharing their 'Me, Myself & I' boxes with their teachers and peers.

Reception have had a disruptive visitor this week – It was George! They have written letters to tell him "**Oh No George!**". They have continued their phonics programme focusing on the letter/sounds c & k.

In mathematics they have looked at grouping objects in sets of 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5. They have also been introduced to the 5 frame.





The Nursery children have been reflecting on their Autumn walk in Victoria Park last Friday. On Monday we put photographs of our trip in chronological order. We then composed a sentence for each photograph and recited an oral recount using words and actions. To develop our mathematical knowledge and understanding, we used objects we collected in the park to count and create patterns and later used our hand print to make an Autumn tree. This week we learnt the song 'Underneath the spreading Chestnut Tree' with actions. We

have been learning information, songs and rhymes about Autumn.
