In Nursery we learned some **pumpkin rhymes**. Our literacy work focused on the story 'Room on the Broom'. There were witches everywhere as Reception children were reading 'Meg & Mog' and have made wonderful portraits of a character from the book.







Reception resumed their phonics programme focusing on the letter/sounds **ck** and **e**. In mathematics they have been practising subitising, consolidating their understanding of 5 frames and positional language. Each Reception class also enjoyed a whole day art workshop from the Art Burst Team which culminated in a performance with music, dancing and masks to an enthusiastic audience of Nursery children on Wednesday afternoon.



Clothing, Water Bottles & Lost Property

As the weather is now more changeable, please ensure that your child wears appropriate clothes to school including a **weatherproof coat** and **footwear**. It remains important that your child has a **spare set of clothes** in their changing bag at school in case they get wet or dirty. This should include spare **socks** and **shoes**. If your child needs to change we will send the dirty clothes home in a plastic bag in their changing bag.

Please ensure spare clothes are replenished and returned the next day. Children also need to continue to bring a **water bottle** into school every day.
