This Week in the EYFS!

We marked our return to school after the half-term holiday with some spooky celebrations! On Monday we had **Halloween** fun, we enjoyed dressing up in costumes and learning about this folk festival. In Nursery we learned some **pumpkin rhymes** and our literacy work focused on the story '**Room on the Broom**'. There were witches everywhere as Reception children were reading '**Meg & Mog**' and made wonderful character studies of a character from the book.







In **Nursery** we will now be having a weekly focus letter/sound in phonics and this week it was <u>s</u> for skeletons, slime, spiders, snakes and spells! **Reception** have continued their phonics programme focusing on the letter/sounds <u>e</u> and <u>u</u> and the digraph (two letters that make one sound) <u>ck.</u> In mathematics they have been developing their knowledge and understanding of 4 and 5 and their numeral recognition and formation of these numbers.

Towards the end of the week **Reception** children learned about the religious festival of Diwali which our Hindu families were celebrating on Thursday. They decorated Diwas and made Rangoli patterns. Friday was all about **Firework Night** of course as we '**Remember, Remember the 5**th of **November – Gunpowder, Treason & Plot!**" with Fireworks in the EYFS garden so we will be going out with a bang this week!
