POSITIVE PARENTING

A WORKSHOP FOCUSED ON UNDERSTANDING CHILDREN'S BEHAVIOUR AND STRATEGIES FOR HOW TO ENCOURAGE MORE POSITIVE BEHAVIOURS

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In Sun Nursery our word of the week has been **celebrations** and we began the second half of the Autumn term with two exciting events in the EYFS. On Monday we had **Halloween** fun, we enjoyed dressing up in costumes and learning about how this folk festival is celebrated. In Nursery we hollowed out pumpkins and made our own pumpkin faces and we learned some **pumpkin rhymes**. Our literacy work focused on the story 'Room on the Broom'. Tuesday was all about **Fireworks Night** as we 'Remember, Remember the 5th of November – Gunpowder, Treason & Plot!' with fireworks in the EYFS garden. We learned about Guy Fawkes. We made some collaborative firework artwork using chalk on black paper as we listened to Handel's Firework music. We continued our learning about letters and sounds with the letter **Bb**. In mathematics we used some pumpkin and firework counting songs, which involved counting forward and back to 10 and recognising numerals from 0-10. We thought about what we do to celebrate different occasions including birthdays.



There were witches everywhere as Reception children were reading 'Meg & Mog' and have been mixing ingredients before writing spooky spells and potions. Their word of the week was **spell**. In addition to celebrating Halloween and Bonfire Night they also learned about **Diwali** and the story of **Rama & Sita**. In the Tower Hamlets Phonics Programme the children have been revising their letter-sound correspondence for the letters **g, o, c & k** and have been practising segmenting and blending words which include the sounds they have learned this half term. They have also been revising the formation of those letters and revised the tricky word **to**. In mathematics they have been looking at two dimensional shapes. They have been finding them in the environment.
