#### This Week in the EYFS







This week **Nursery** have continued opening their **Advent Calendar** and counting down the days to Christmas and the Christmas holiday. Our word of the week has been **Nativity** as we have been learning about the story of the very first Christmas. We also made saltdough decorations for our Christmas tree, Christmas cards and a Christmas tree themed headress for our Christmas performance next week. This week we learned two new **letters and sounds** in phonics: Ff & Gg. We are thinking about things that begin with those letters/sounds and are clapping the syllables in each word to develop our phonological awareness.

Reception have continued their learning themed around 'Blue Penguin' by Petr Horacek. This week they have focused on finding out all about penguins. They have read a range of information texts to develop their knowledge and understanding of the world. They have learned about the many different species of penguin (ask them to name some!) and learned some facts about them. They then made penguin posters to record their findings. In the Tower Hamlets Phonics Programme the children have been learning the letter-sound correspondence for **Jj & Vv**. They have also been making Christmas decorations.

On **Thursday** EYFS children had the privilege of watching the dress rehearsal of this year's Key Stage 1 Nativity production in St Barnabas Church which was fantastic!

This week we have continued practising the Christmas songs and rhymes which we hope you will enjoy hearing when you join us next Thursday.
