This Week in the EYFS!

This week is **anti-bullying week** and so we began the week in odd socks to emphasise our individuality and differences and how we can see this as positive and a strength of our school. We also talked about how we can be kind and kinder in how we behave towards each other, our families and other living things.

Nursery now have a weekly focus letter/sound in phonics and this week it has been **Tt** for Tracy, Teddy and tea. We are thinking about things that begin with that letter/sound and are clapping the syllables in each word. We learned about the history of the Teddy Bear and read stories and learnt some rhymes and songs about Teddy Bears. We prepared for our **Teddy Bears Picnic** on Friday by writing **invitations** to our own teddy or bed time snuggly and writing a list of what we need to do to prepare for our picnic.







Reception have been reading the story 'This is the Bear and the Picnic Lunch' by Sarah Hayes. They have painted teddy bears and drawn pictures of the Teddy Bears Picnic of their dreams! They have continued their phonics programme focusing on the letter/sounds $\underline{\mathbf{f}}$ and including $\underline{\mathbf{ff}}$. In mathematics they have been consolidating their knowledge and understanding of number and numerical patterns.

Throughout the unit we have been busy preparing for our **Teddy Bears Picnic** for **Children in Need** on Friday. We made honey biscuits and marmalade sandwiches. We enjoyed 'Marvellous things to eat and wonderful games to play!' with our Teddy or Snuggly. We hope they enjoyed it!
