Today is **World Children's Day** (20th November) which is the 31st anniversary of the Convention on the Rights of the Child. 'the most complete statement of children's rights ever produced and the most widely-ratified international human rights treaty in history'(UNICEF).



The convention specifies the rights children have to provision, protection and participation (the 3 ps). These are detailed in Articles. For example: **Article 28: Every child has the right to an education.** Chisenhale Primary School achieved the Gold Award as a United Nations Rights Respecting School in January 2020. Thank you for helping us to continue your child's education during the circumstances of the closure of the EYFS. We are looking forward to seeing your child back at school on Monday!
