## This Week in the EYFS

In **Nursery** we read the story '**The Dot'** by Peter Reynolds, a story about a girl who learns to make her mark – and sign it! We have been making dot and spot drawings and paintings, inspired by Damien Hirst and Wassily Kandinsky. Our Word of the Week has been **letters** as we have been looking closely at our own names – identifying the initial capital letter and counting how many letters there are in our names. We have looked at the position of our initial letter/sound in the alphabet. We also learnt a name rhyme as we explored similarities and differences in our names. We have also introduced the UN charter on the Rights of the Child as we have the right to a name and nationality (Article 8). In the Think Equal PHSE programme we thought about our emotions and feelings. We continued our learning about letters and sounds with the letter **Dd**.












Reception have continued their work on their topic 'Vets & Pets'. Their Word of the Week has been Vet.. They have created a story map for 'Oh No George!' and written their own alternative version of the story. In the Tower Hamlets Phonics Programme the children have been learning the letter-sound correspondence for the short vowel sounds for Bb & Hh. They have also been learning the correct formation of those letters and been introduced to six new tricky words: put, as, has, into, I and her. They have also been composing and performing their own Helicopter Stories. In mathematics they have been investigating the numbers 4 & 5, including reading and writing the numerals and exploring number bonds.



On **Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> December** EYFS children will be able to watch the pantomime performance of **Aladdin** by the **Stage Ed Theatre Company** in school. You will be receiving a letter to request a parental contribution to cover the cost of this experience.
