This Week in the EYFS.


In **Nursery** this half term our topic is **Traditional Rhymes and Tales**. We read, role-played and discussed **'The Great Race'** which is the traditional story of how, in the Chinese calendar, years came to be named after animals. We found out about our own Chinese Zodiac sign (we are either dogs or roosters!). We sang a **New Year Song**, and did **ribbon** and **dragon dancing**. We have also continued our phonics learning, adding **d** to our Set 1 sounds of s,a,t,p,l,n. Using the context of a race, we learnt about **ordinal numbers** (1st, 2nd, 3rd etc.) in Mathematics.







Reception classes have been learning about China. They have also learnt about the Chinese Zodiac. They made lanterns and dragons. They are continuing to develop their phonic knowledge (letters q & qu this week) In mathematics, Reception have been ordering numbers up to 10 and dealing with a naughty Kangaroo who keeps messing their number lines up. Book Bags & Reading

Your child needs to bring their book bag into school **every day**. Please check their book bag for important letters or information. We will be inviting your child to choose a book to take home and share with you every **Friday**.

Children in Reception are also issued with a **Bug Club login**. This is an **online reading resource** where class teachers allocate texts. Parents should log on **weekly** for children to practise reading an appropriate level of text using their developing phonic knowledge. When children are given this opportunity to read to and with parents at home it makes a real difference to their fluency and has a positive impact on their progress and attainment in reading.

<u>Clothing, Water Bottles & Lost Property</u> We sent all changing bags home at the end of last term

Please ensure that your child returns to school a **spare set of clothes** (underwear, a top, leggings or jogging bottoms) in their changing bag in case they get wet or dirty. This should include spare **socks** and **shoes**.
