This Week in the EYFS

This week Nursery admitted four new children with part-time places into Sun Class. We are now officially a full class with 36 children on roll. Our word of the week has been **Resolution** as we have been embedding our whole class resolution which is to show we are 'Ready to Learn' by doing good sitting, good looking and good listening during carpet time. Our topic in Nursery this half term is **traditional rhymes** and stories. We have begun by revisiting some familiar **nursery rhymes** and have been practising reciting them out loud in our classrooms.







Reception classes' Word of the Week has been **wander** which is a word from their literacy text 'Blue Penguin' by Petr Horacek. They have written a letter to the Blue Penguin. They have also been researching facts about penguins by using non-fiction texts.

In phonics, they have continued Phase 3 of the Tower Hamlets Phonics Programme and have been learning the letters w and x. In Mathematics they have been practising finding one more and one less than a given number.





Book Bags & Reading

Your child needs to bring their book bag into school every day.
