The end of this Half Term will be Friday 10th February.


We will return to school on Monday 20th February.

This Week in the EYFS

Thanks to all the parents who joined us in school for 'Blue Monday' – we hope you enjoyed a positive start to your week!

This week in Nursery our word of the week has been **spy**. We have been playing the game 'I spy' and also encountering the word in our key text 'Each Peach Pear Plum'. Our topic in Nursery this half term is **traditional rhymes** and **stories** so we identified the characters in the text and listened to and read the rhymes and stories that they feature in.

Reception classes' Word of the Week has been **dream** which is a word from their literacy text. They have continued their work on 'Blue Penguin', including making their own penguin using a balloon and papier-mâché. They have also been introducing the children to 'Helicopter Stories'. In phonics, they have continued Phase 3 of the Tower Hamlets Phonics Programme and have been learning the letters x, y and z. In Mathematics they have been combining groups to find a total and comparing and measuring height.



Book Bags & Reading

Your child needs to bring their book bag into school every day.

Clothing, Water Bottles & Lost Property
