### **This Week in the EYFS**

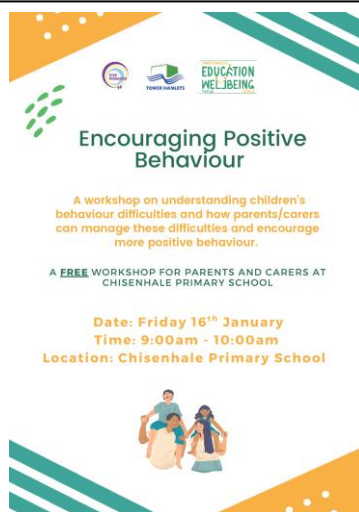
We have been delighted at how well the children have adjusted to being back in school after the Christmas holidays and they are already showing us that they are ready for more wonderful learning.

We have also welcomed eight new children and their families to Nursery this week. They have made a very positive start to their time in Sun Class.

In Nursery our word of the week has been **calendar** as we have been identifying important dates (such as our birthdays) alongside learning about **New Year celebrations** and **traditions** including singing Auld Lang Syne and deciding on Sun Class and individual **New Year resolutions**. We have also been identifying the months of the year and the seasons.



This half term our Reception classes have begun by looking at traditional tales. They have been identifying a range of stories from this genre and have been voting on which tale they would most like to study in more depth. In phonics, the children have been focusing on the digraph **ch** and demonstrating their retention of the learning from last term by completing a reading sheet. In mathematics they have been subitising numbers to 5 and identifying the number that is one less. They have also learned how to read and write tally charts.



During our Parents' Evening meetings quite a few families mentioned that their children were having emotional outbursts outside of school that they were finding it difficult to understand or know how to respond effectively to support their child.
