**This Week in the EYFS**

It's been a busy week in Nursery as we have welcomed five new children and their families. Thank you for your support as we are settling and introducing all our January cohort to the routines and expectations of their new school.

In Nursery our word of the week has been **Resolutions** as we have been writing our own New Year Resolutions and decorating our Resolution stars. We have continued our phonics learning with the letter **li**. We have been exploring number through number rhymes such as 'One Finger, One Thumb, Keep Moving'.



Reception classes have continued their exploration of traditional tales. They have been looking at different versions of the same story and comparing the plot, language, themes and features. They enjoyed an interactive drama session for the 'The Three Little Pigs' and a Drama4All workshop on Friday. In phonics, the children have been focusing on the digraphs sh and th in tricky words like push and they. In mathematics they have been consolidating their knowledge of numbers up to 5, counting up and down, subitising (recognising numbers presented in a variety of ways without having to count), using vocabulary such as 'more' and 'fewer' accurately to compare numbers and knowing number bonds.
