




Celebrations & Events

There are stewards and signposting throughout or you can find information online <https://canarywharf.com/winter-lights/>



Half Term


The Half Term Holiday will be from **Monday 16th – Friday 20th February**.

This Week in the EYFS

In Nursery our Word of the Week has been **rhyme** as our topic this half term is **Traditional Rhymes and Stories**. Our key text is **'Each Peach Pear Plum'**. We identified the characters in the text and listened to and recited the rhymes and stories that they feature in. We looked at the words that rhymed in the text then we chose our favourite characters and explained why we liked them. We then put this information on a **pictogram**. We have enjoyed playing the game **'I spy'**. We read the book **'Kitchen Disco'** and learned to clap the syllables in the names of all the fruits in the book and many more! We continued our phonics learning with the letter **Kk** We have been exploring number through number rhymes such as **'Two Little Dicky Birds'**.



Reception classes have continued their exploration of **Space** and the **Solar System** and have been fascinated by learning more about the topic through a range of non-fiction texts. Crossbills really enjoyed exploring gravity, whilst Capercaillies have been drawn to Black Holes! They also read **'Astro Girl'** by Ken Wilson Max. In phonics, the children have been focusing on the digraphs **ng** and **nk**. In mathematics they have been recognising the numerals 6, 7 & 8 T and exploring the composition of each number.
