
The Easter holiday will be from Monday 7th - Tuesday 22nd April. Back to school on Wednesday 23rd

This Week in the EYFS

In Nursery we are marching into March and welcoming the Spring days ahead. We read 'Pancakes, Pancakes!' by Eric Carle and on Shrove Tuesday we enjoyed eating a pancake at the Pancake Café in Sun Class. We also wrote a recipe for pancakes and drew a pancake with our favourite topping. Our 'word of the week' has been 'rhyme'. We have been learning to identify rhyming words in texts and have begun to be able to generate our own rhyming strings. We learned a rhyme about pancakes. We have added Mm to the letters that we can name and sound in our phonic knowledge.







Reception Classes have had a busy week in and out of school. At the beginning of the week they went to the Bow Idea Store to learn about libraries and hear a story. They have also been learning to sew and weave as they are making their own bookmarks in design & technology. This week has been a revision week in phonics of all the long vowel digraphs and trigraphs. In mathematics they have been exploring the numbers 9 and 10.

On Thursday we marked World Book Day with a parade through the EYFS garden, dressed up as book characters. We celebrated reading throughout the school day and our celebrations also included a visit to Bard Books on Roman Road to exchange our book vouchers.
