End of Day Arrangements

The Green Screens are now in place outside the EYFS gate and Chisenhale Road gate. They are ready for parents to wait safely and socially distanced when dropping off and collecting their children.

This seems to be working in the morning, but is more problematic in the evening. I am aware that the system of queuing to the right (for Nursery parents) is now difficult so I propose that Nursery parents queue **against the wall** for pick up at the end of the day, whilst Reception parents queue **against the Green Screens**. All queuing from the gate towards the school office.
