This Week in the EYFS


In **Nursery** we continued learning about rhyme and rhyming strings as we read "**Down the Back of the Chair**" which was our phonics focus for this half term. We learned to recite '**Mary, Mary Quite Contrary**' and our 'word of the week' has been '**plant**' as we followed up our Talking Time text '**Lulu Loves Flowers**' by planting sunflower seeds in Sun Class. We have begun to make our own 'Flower Books' to record our gardening efforts. We also read '**Ten Seeds**' by Ruth Brown and learned about the lifecycle of sunflowers. We drew and counted sets of sunflower seeds up to 10. We have added **Nn** to the letters that we can name and sound in our phonic knowledge.







Reception Classes have started to learn about ducks – they must be quackers! They are learning all about the lifecycle of ducks and other duck facts. They have made some 3D and 2D ducks using paper plates and hand prints. They have also been reading stories about ducks. I wonder if they already know who our special visitors are going to be? They have been revising the long vowel digraphs oa and oo and the 'Tricky Words' are & we. In mathematics they have been exploring the number bonds to 10.
