## This week in the EYFS

We have welcomed two new children, Ray & Luca, into Sun Nursery this week.

This week in Nursery we have been learning about our brains. We have learned the name and function of different parts of the brain, specifically the cerebrum, cerebellum and amygdala. We have also explored how neurons in our brains are responsible for carrying messages to other parts of our body. We have added **Ee** to the letters that we can name and sound in our phonic knowledge. Our 'Word of the Week' has been 'Eid' as we were looking forward to our celebrations on Friday.







Reception have been learning about the traditions and celebrations associated with **Eid** in preparation for our Eid celebrations on Friday. Their word of the week has been **compass**. In phonics, they have begun Phase 4 of the Tower Hamlets Phonics Programme and have been learning to read and write words ending in the adjacent final consonants st, mp, ft, It and nd. In mathematics the children have been learning to order numbers from 0-10.

On Friday our Eid Celebrations included learning a rhyme, playing a balloon game, writing numbers in Arabic, Mehndi, and eating Vermicelli pudding and Eid biscuits with honey, apple and banana.
