This half term all our classes will be visiting Discover Children's Story Centre at Stratford for their '100 Storey Hotel' immersive experience and story-building workshop. Clothing, Water Bottles & Lost Property

Please ensure your child's changing bag is replenished and returned to school promptly. Your child needs a **spare set of clothes** (underwear, a top, leggings or jogging bottoms) in their changing bag in case they get wet or dirty. This should include spare **socks** and **shoes**.

All personal property should be labelled clearly with your child's name and class!

Children also need to continue to bring a **water bottle** into school every day, and if the weather is warm, they may also need a (named) sun hat and sunscreen applied before they arrive at school.

## This Week in the EYFS

This week we welcomed **Eesa** to Sun Class, where we have been sharing the story '**Odd Dog Out**' by the author and illustrator **Rob Biddulph**. We have watched him demonstrate how to '**Draw with Rob**' and have learned how to create our own sausage dog characters. In this story the main character learns to accept that she is different and unique. Our **Think Equal** curriculum has also looked at difference and diversity. We continued our phonics learning, and have now added **b** for **boot** to the letters and sounds that we know. On Friday we marked **Earth Day** with learning activities which focused on our planet, and what we can do to help protect it for the future.



In Reception, the children have been reading 'Hello Friend' by Rebecca Cobb, which has supported topic work and discussions about friendship as the children have been building a 'Castle of Friendship'. In mathematics they have been introduced to the early 'teens' numbers as they have explored place value to record numbers beyond 10. Their literacy learning is now focused on practising using and applying their phonic knowledge to read and write appropriate texts with increasing levels of independence.

### Book Bags & Reading

Your child needs to bring their book bag into school **every day**. Please check their book bag for important letters or information. We will be inviting your child to choose a book to take home and share with you every **Friday**.

Children in Reception are also issued with a **Bug Club login**. This is an **online reading resource** where class teachers allocate texts. Parents should log on **weekly** for children to practise reading an appropriate level of text using their developing phonic knowledge. When children are given this opportunity to read to and with parents at home it makes a real difference to their fluency and has a positive impact on their progress and attainment in reading.
