## This week in the EYFS

This week in Nursery our word of the week has been 'metamorphosis'. On Monday (20th May) we celebrated 'World **Bee Day**'. Bees are another living thing that changes from egg to lava to pupa to adult during their lifecycle. We read information books about bees and learned the 'Buzzy Bees Counting Song' which helped us to understand that you can count on from 5. Our ten tiny catepillars have metamorphosised into Painted Lady Butterflies and we set them free in the warmth of the sun on Thursday afternoon. We have added Ff to the letters that we can name and sound in our phonic knowledge. We also went on a trip to Spitalfields City **Farm** where we were able to enjoy seeing a range of farm animals including sheep, goats, a pig called Holmes, a ferret, ducks, chickens and four donkeys.

In Reception this week children continued their topic about farming in advance of their trip to Stepney City Farm. Following their trip they have been writing their individual recounts of the visit. They also read 'Farmer Duck' by Martin Waddell and enjoyed a farm-themed 'Now Press Play' experience. In phonics they are progressing through Phase 4 of the Tower Hamlets Phonics Programme and have been learning to read and write CCVCC words and multi syllable words. In mathematics the children have been listening to number stories which include addition calculations.
