Holidays and school closure


School will be closed on Thursday

This week in the EYFS

In Nursery our word of the week has been 'water'. We began our topic of 'Water, Water Everywhere!' by thinking about how important this element is for all living things. We investigated water using our senses before we read 'Big Red Bath' by Julia Jarman. We made pictures by dripping and dropping paint. We also explored floating and sinking and Archimedes' Principle as we added animals to the bathwater. We have added Rr to the letters that we can name and sound in our phonic knowledge.







In Reception children began this term with a topic looking at the Season of Summer. In phonics they are progressing through Phase 4 of the Tower Hamlets phonics Programme and have been learning to read and write words with adjacent consonants and writing short sentences from dictation. In **mathematics** the children have been listening to number stories which include **subtraction**.
