Parents are very welcome to attend these events!


### This Week in the EYFS

Thanks to all those parents who came along to see our 'Procession' on Friday and EYFS Sports Day on Monday. It was great for the children to have your support and encouragement and we hope you enjoyed it!

This week Nursery have been learning about the Ocean. We have read 'I Spy under the sea' and have been thinking about the creatures who live there. We continued our phonics learning and have now added y to the letters and sounds that we know. We have looked at the sound this letter makes e.g in names like Yaqub!







Reception classes have been thinking about the future! They have been upstairs to look at the layout of the school, and the location of the Year 1 classrooms and toilets. They have been thinking about change and transitions and making preparations for the end of their time in the Early Years Foundation Stage. This has included finishing off their Learning Journeys which are a great testimony to the amazing progress they have made over the last year.

### **Meet the Teacher**

Next Tuesday afternoon (12<sup>th</sup> July) your child will have the opportunity to meet their teacher for the next academic year. Reception children will be going upstairs to Year 1 and Nursery children will be going into one of the two Reception classes. Parents will then be informed of their child's teacher and class name for 2022-23.

Nursery and Reception children have been allocated to a particular class based on a range of criteria. Your child's current class teacher has completed detailed assessments in the last month and these have informed the decisions which we have made.

In addition to creating classes which have similar profiles in academic progress and attainment we have also considered children's personalities, their relationships with each other, learning styles, and gender balance in order to create a cohesive class. Each Reception class will also include eight children who will be new to Chisenhale in September.

We hope that this will help to ensure that your child has the best environment to continue to flourish in the forthcoming year.
