This Week in the EYFS

This week in Nursery we have begun learning about **Art & Artists** ahead of our visit to **Tate Britain**. We have looked at some famous paintings and talked about the subject, context and medium that the artists used, and that works of art are displayed in galleries. We have also been making our own artworks. We continued our phonics learning, and have now added **v** for **van** to the letters and sounds that we know. During the next two weeks we will be carrying out assessment activities to inform our report writing.



The Reception classes began the new half term developing their knowledge and understanding of the season of **Summer**. They have written their 'Bucket List' for the Summer. In phonics the children have been consolidating their knowledge of vowel digraphs and trigraphs. In mathematics they have been identifying and creating patterns using blocks.



Clothing, Water Bottles & Lost Property

Please ensure your child's changing bag is replenished and returned to school promptly. Your child needs a **spare set of clothes** (underwear, a top, leggings or jogging bottoms) in their changing bag in case they get wet or dirty. This should include spare **socks** and **shoes**.

All personal property should be labelled clearly with your child's name and class!

Children should also continue to bring a **water bottle** into school every day, and if the weather is warm, they may also need a **(named) sun hat** and sunscreen applied before they arrive at school.

Book Bags & Reading

Your child needs to bring their book bag into school **every day**. Please check their book bag for important letters or information. We will be inviting your child to choose a book to take home and share with you every **Friday**.

Children in Reception are also issued with a **Bug Club login**. This is an **online reading resource** where class teachers allocate texts. Parents should log on **weekly** for children to practise reading an appropriate level of text using their developing phonic knowledge. When children are given this opportunity to read to and with parents at home it makes a real difference to their fluency and has a positive impact on their progress and attainment in reading.
