This Week in the EYFS

In Nursery our word of the week has been river as we have been preparing for our trip next week. We began the week by reading 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' by John Burningham. This is set on a river. We enjoyed using small world characters and role-playing the story. We also learned about the river Thames and docklands ahead of our trip next Monday. We identified some London landmarks that we will see on our Uber boat trip to Westminster. We reached the penultimate letter of the alphabet (Yy) this week and practised blending and segmenting words from the THEP Phonics programme. In the Think Equal programme we have been learning about 'special hair', and made cool fingerprint pictures to show our individuality and creative flair.







Reception classes made a successful trip to Canary Wharf to conclude their transport topic by riding on buses and the DLR. Their favourite sights were the giant yellow duck, the DLR and the colourful bridge and tunnel. They enjoyed having lunch in the beautiful roof garden where they marvelled at the huge plants and also recognised some interesting sculptures. Reception classes also got to join the rest of the school for an assembly and the Rocksteady Concert. To conclude the THEP phonics programme for this year the children have been writing more words with adjacent consonants and writing sentences that include the tricky words they have learned. In mathematics they have been revising number bonds to 10 and writing number sentences.

Health Issues in the EYFS

Please continue to be vigilant as we still have children with **chickenpox** Please see the NHS website for symptoms. https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/chickenpox/

Chickenpox is infectious from 1 to 2 days before the rash starts. It stops being infectious when all the blisters have crusted over (5 - 6 days after the start). If your child has chickenpox, it is important that they stay away from school until

there is no further risk of infecting another child or adult. Also NHS guidelines state that if your child has vomited or had diarrhoea they must be symptom-free for 48 hours before returning to school to prevent infecting others.

These control measures are particularly important as we have children in the unit who have compromised immune systems and infections and viruses could significantly impact their health.



Clothing, Water Bottles & Lost Property

Please ensure spare clothes are replenished and returned in changing bags.

As the weather turns warmer please consider providing a sun hat (named, please) and applying **sunscreen** to your child to protect them from the sun.

Children also need to continue to bring a water bottle into school every day.

All personal property should be labelled clearly with your child's name and class!

It will help us to help your child to learn to look after their property.
