The final school day of this year will be **Friday 21**st **July, w**hen school will close at **2pm.**


The first day back is Tuesday 5th September.

This Week in the EYFS

This week in Nursery we have continued our exploration of art & artists. We read 'Snail Trail' by Jo Saxton, 'Matisse – Dance for Joy' by Susan Goldman Rubin and 'Matisse's Magical Trail' by Tim Hopgood & Sam Boughton. We made our own art works in response including 'Action Painting' like Jackson Pollock, and making more collages as we learned about the work of Henri Matisse, and particularly the cut outs or 'painting with scissors' that he did at the end of his life. This week we added Qq to the letters that we can name and sound in our phonic knowledge. On Friday we were fascinated by the number of snails that emerged in the rain!







In the Reception classes children have continued to explore the theme of **movement** as they have been choreographing ribbon dances in their classrooms, which they will be showcasing to their parents at the beginning of the Art Exhibition. They have also been telling and acting out **Helicopter Stories** (we were all so inspired by watching 'Fantastic Mr Fox'). In the Tower Hamlets Phonics Programme they have been learning adjacent consonants **br**, **sw**, **fl**, **& sp** in words like bridge, swim, fly, & spin

On Friday we were delighted to have so many visitors to our Art Exhibition in our classes. We hope you enjoyed it!

End of Term Reports

As we head towards the end of the Summer Term you will receive your child's end of year report. This takes the place of a Parent Consultation meeting at this point in the year. EYFS reports focus on the 'Characteristics of Effective Learning' and also indicate if your child has achieved Age Related Expectations in all the 17 areas of the curriculum. For Reception children it shows if they have met the Early Learning Goals for each aspect.
