In **Nursery** we read 'I am a pirate'. We have learned to 'Talk Like a Pirate' at Pirate School. We made pirate eye patches and hats and drew a pirate treasure map. We enjoyed singing pirate songs and have enjoyed singing and drumming along to the 'Wellerman' song (Twinkl version). In mathematics we have been counting objects and recognising numerals up to 10. Our phonic learning has been the letter 'Zz' for zip – which means that children in Nursery now have a letter-sound correspondence for all the letters of the alphabet!

Reception classes have continued to think about the transition they will be making to Key Stage 1 in September and have made books for their new teachers in Year 1. In their topic learning they have learned about what to expect from their beach trip on Friday and are also preparing for the 'pirate & mermaid' party on Monday. Their mathematical learning has been focused on problem solving with a seaside theme.
