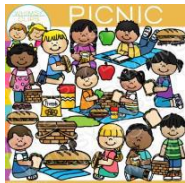
Sun Nursery are going on a trip to **Sea Life London Aquarium** on **Tuesday 2nd July**.

### This week in the EYFS

In Nursery our word of the week has been '**poetry**' as we joined the rest of the school for **Poetry Week**. We read poems from '**Commotion in the Ocean**' by Giles Andreae about sea creatures. We chose which poems we wanted to learn to recite and then added some actions and performed for our friends. Later in the week we wrote our own acrostic poem about water. In our topic we have also been thinking about how boats have changed over time. They enjoyed learning about 'The Golden Hind', 'Cutty Sark' and the kinds of boats that have added **Vv** to the letters that we can name and sound in our phonic knowledge. We have also focused on number 7 in mathematics.



In Reception children learned a song about **Space**. They have collaborated on writing their own poem about **Planet Earth** which they have been learning to recite and will be performing in the Poetry Slam on Friday. We are delighted to report that Reception classes have completed Phase 4 of the Tower Hamlets Phonics Programme. We can now assess what they have learned and can use and apply effectively. Then the teachers will be planning revision activities to address any gaps in knowledge. In **mathematics** the children have been learning about **doubling**.
