This Week in the EYFS

In **Nursery** we have had **two** 'words of the week' – **poetry & rhyme** as we have been celebrating **Poetry Week** at Chisenhale. We continued our focus on **British wild animals** as we listened to, read, recited and composed poems. We learned the **'Magpie'** number rhyme. We looked at animal shape poems by **Liz Brownlee** such as 'The Wren' before writing our own poem about bats. We read an acrostic poem about a robin then wrote our own about the Magpie. We then practised and performed the poems we learned in the EYFS Poetry Slam event on Thursday. We have reached the letter sound **Yy** in the THEP phonics programme – one more letter to go!



Reception classes' **Terrific Transport** topic has rumbled on! They have read poems about transport and they have written their own **transport poems** and performed them in the EYFS Poetry Slam. They have been preparing for their trip on Friday by looking at the Tube map and planning their journey. They have continued to develop their positional language and mapping skills by reading books featuring maps. They are currently on Phase 4 of the Tower Hamlets phonics programme and have been reading and writing words that end with adjacent consonants and multi-syllable words.
