

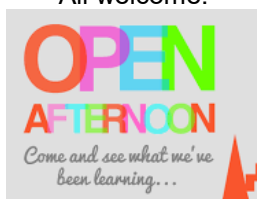


Celebrations & events

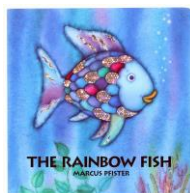
Summer term

This week in the EYFS

In **Nursery** our word of the week has been **friendship**. We read **'The Rainbow Fish'** by **Marcus Pfister**, and **'Angeli's Kite'** and thought and talked about how we can develop friendships through acts of kindness and sharing. We talked about, and drew, our own friends and thought about how we are all connected to each other through our relationships. We are learning the song 'You've got a friend' from Toy Story – which we are hoping to sing for you next Friday. We have reached the letter sound **Zz** in the THEP phonics programme.



The **Terrific Transport** topic has reached the terminus for the Reception classes! They recalled their epic transport trip on Friday by looking at and sequencing photographs of their journey before writing a recount of their adventures. They have been enjoying the hot weather and all the opportunities for water play in the classroom and in the garden. They have been taking their turn in the paddling pool and indoors they have been making their own boats, using their knowledge and understanding of floating and sinking and waterproofing to stop them from sinking. In mathematics they have been creating more maps and diagrams including thinking about their place in the universe – right down to their bedrooms. They are close to completing Phase 4 of the Tower Hamlets phonics programme and have been reading and writing longer (CCVCC) words, including in sentences.



Reception Classes will be holding their **Graduation Ceremony** on **Monday 20th July** from **1.30pm** in the school hall.
