East London Brewing Company Pale Ale -500ml -

Brewed by legendary Chisenhale parents, Claire and Stuart, ELB Pale Ale is a crisp, lighter ale with a subtle bitterness and a fruity perfumed aroma. It's an excellent session beer.



Tarabilla Blanco 2018, Bodegas Gallegas, Galicia, Spain - £12.00

A delicious blend that makes this is very easy drinking and full of fresh green apple, citrus and pear flavours, with attractive balance and a clean, crisp finish.



Tarabilla Red 2018, Bodegas Gallegas, Galicia, Spain - £12.00

A three-way blend of peppery Garnacha and rich Tempranillo with a dollop of Cabernet Sauvignon to add a little structure. Warm and beautifully balanced, this is perfect on its own or with grilled meats and tapas.



Azumbre Verdejo 2018, DO Rueda, Spain - £17.00
On the palate, this Verdejo displays citrussy notes and stone fruit with an appetising, fresh finish



Botijo Rojo Garnacha, Valdejalón, Spain 2018-£17.00

A lovely pomegranate red colour with intense aromas of cherries, blackberries, and the slight spice of pepper. This is a bold, fresh and fruity wine with balanced tannins and minerality, reflecting the simplicity and ingenuity of its namesake.

If you have any lying around, please leave them outside the Schoolhouse door on Zealand Road (NB this is **NOT** the school office or the school gates but the Schoolhouse door behind the black gate which can be pushed open)

While you're here:

Liveable Streets - Bow

The levels of air pollution on our streets (and outside our school) are unacceptably high, causing long-term health risks for our children. Surveys show over **16,000 journeys every day** are made by non-residents cutting

through Bow, increasing the pollution we all have to suffer. Proposals have been put forward to invest in the local area to reduce rat-running (i.e. vehicles using our neighbourhood streets as cut-throughs) and improve road safety, air quality and public spaces. Significantly for Chisenhale parents, the changes include making the streets around our school safer for children by reducing traffic, improving cycle lanes and widening footpaths.

This is your chance to have your say. Please discuss with your children, and hopefully you'll be able to support the proposals and help improve air-quality in Bow for all our families. https://talk.towerhamlets.gov.uk/lsbow
