The Children's Commissioner for England, Dame Rachel de Souza, is launching a once-in-a-generation review of the lives of children and young people.

It's called 'The Childhood Commission' and it will identify the barriers preventing children reaching their full potential and propose policy solutions to address them.

This has never been done before.

At its heart is 'The Big Ask' – the largest ever consultation held with children.

In this survey the Children's Commissioner is asking children and young people what they think is important for their future and what might be holding them back.

The Children's Commissioner will use what children and young people tell her to show the Government what they think and what they need to live happier lives.

It is an exciting opportunity for us to hear from our children and young people and a chance for every child and young person in Tower Hamlets to have their voice heard.
