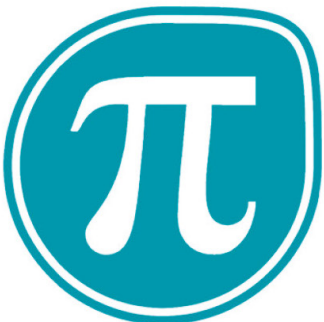
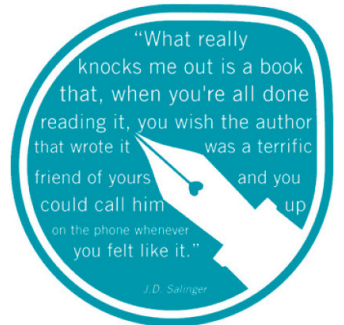
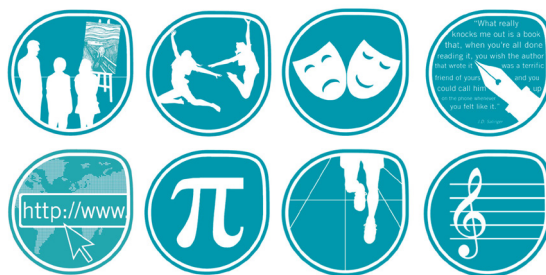

To book your child onto a club, please do so via the school gateway app.

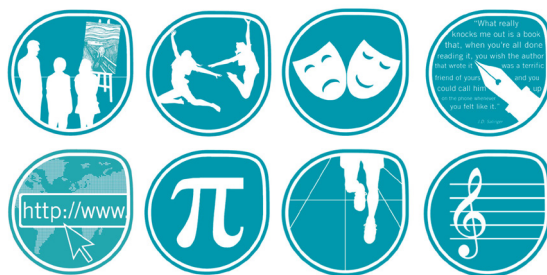
To do this:

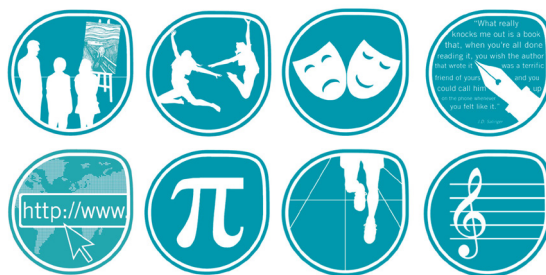


RIGHTS ACTION CLUB

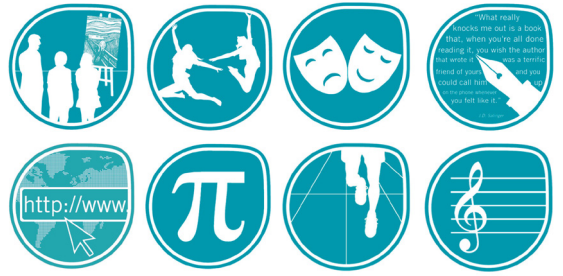


SCHOOL FOOD CHAMPIONS

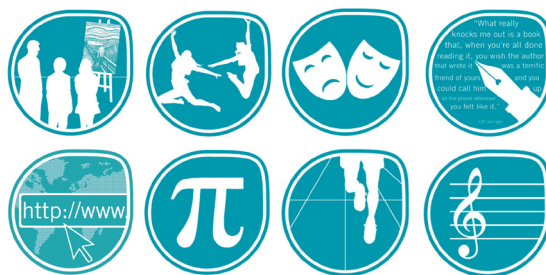

- The opportunity to interact with students in all year groups!

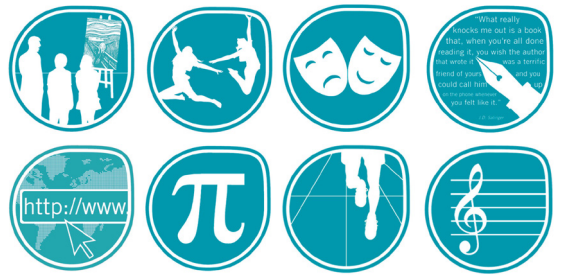
